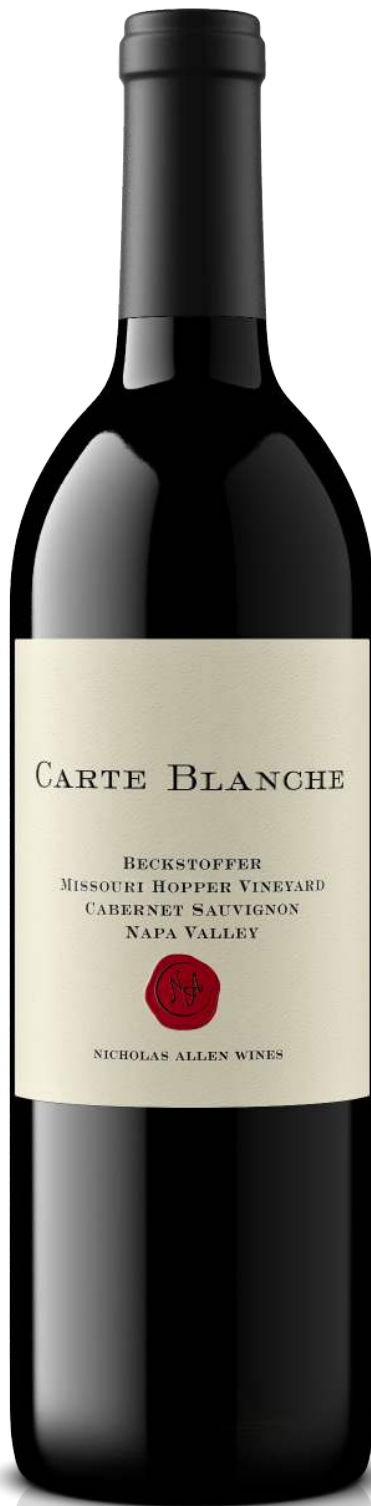

SOIL:	Alluvial silty clay loam with gravels
ABV:	14.7%
YIELD:	2.5 tons per acre average
BARREL AGING:	22 months
COOPERAGE:	75% New French oak barrels from Taransaud and Sylvain coopers
TASTING NOTE:	Deep opaque purple color. Fresh and vibrant on the nose, with striking crème de cassis aromas, accented by fig cake, blueberry jam, and mocha. In both the aromas and on the palate, the oak used in this wine's upbringing is beautifully well-integrated. Mouthfilling, with soft tannins, this is balanced and harmonious overall, with hints of cappuccino coursing through the minutes-long finish. It's a wine with decades to go in the tank.
